

**CITY OF MARION – CONTINUED MEETING**

**JUNE 4, 2012**

Minutes of a Continued Meeting of the City Council of the City of Marion held in the Council Chambers of the Marion City Hall June 04, 2012. Mayor Butler called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M.

The City Clerk was instructed to call the roll and the response was as follows:

PHYSICALLY PRESENT: COMISSIONERS RIX, RINELLA, GOSS, PATTON AND MAYOR BUTLER.  
ABSENT: NONE

Mayor Butler presented the amended Right of Way Agreement with Clearwave. Mayor Butler told the Council that the addition of the clause to charge a \$10,000.00 penalty each time Clearwave fails to get an easement sure got their attention. The representative from Clearwave apologized for Clearwaves's prior activity. The representative said Clearwave could live with a \$1,000.00 penalty. After discussion, it was decided that Sections 21 and 16 should remain as printed. Mayor Butler asked for any other suggested changes. There being no other suggested changes, Commissioner Patton made a motion to accept the Right of Way Agreement as presented. Commissioner Rix seconded the motion.

ORDINANCE 3053 – AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR MARION TAX INCREMENT FINANCING DISTRICT VII (GOLF/RESIDENTIAL TIF DISTRICT) BY AND BETWEEN JACOB & KLEIN, LTD; THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT GROUP, LTD; AND THE CITY OF MARION. Commissioner Goss made a motion to accept Ordinance 3053 as presented. Commissioner Rinella seconded the motion.

There are several stop signs and a low speed limit in that stretch of the road, all of which are frequently disobeyed. Commissioner Rix will present more information on both of these situations at a future Council Meeting.
