

CITY OF MARION – SPECIAL CALLED MEETING

July 11, 2013

Minutes of a Special Called Meeting of the City Council of the City of Marion held in the Council Chambers of the Marion City Hall Thursday July 11, 2013. Mayor Butler called the meeting to order at 10:00 A.M. The City Clerk was instructed to call the roll and the response was as follows:

ABSENT: COMMISSIONER PATTON

The purpose of the Special Called Meeting was to approve hiring of Katherine Short for a full time Clerk position for the Street Department and Cemetery Department, amend the EMA Director Job Description, and meet with representatives from Twin Supplies Lighting Proposal.

Commissioner Goss made a motion to approve the hiring of Katherine Short as a full time clerk effective July 15, 2013 for the Street Department and the Cemetery Department. Commissioner Rinella seconded the motion.

The revisions for the EMA Job Description were presented. Council concurred with the revisions of the EMA Job Description. Consensus of the Council was that Ordinance 3032 needs to be amended to reflect the changes in the powers and duties of the EMA Director.

Representatives of Twin supplies, Chicago, Illinois, met with the Council and presented their information for replacing lighting fixtures and light bulbs throughout the City of Marion buildings to make the lights more energy efficient. Before making a decision Council decided to check with local Electric Contractors that offer the same type of light replacements as Twin Supplies.

Commissioner Rix made a motion to adjourn meeting with Commissioner Goss seconding the motion.
