April 4, 2016

Minutes of a Special Meeting held at Marion City Hall Monday April 4, 2016 at 4:30

P.M. Mayor Butler called the meeting to order. The roll call response was as follows:

Commissioner Goss made a motion to approve the pay rates changes for the Hub Recreation Center as listed above. Commissioner Webb seconded the motion.

Commissioner Webb made a motion to approve the transfer of Michael Anderson from the Hub to the Library as a Circulation Clerk with Commissioner Hightower seconding the motion.

ON ROLL CALL VOTE COMMISSIONERS RINELLA AND GOSS VOTED NO. COMMISSIONERS HIGHTOWER AND WEBB AND MAYOR BUTLER ALL VOTED YEA.

Commissioner Goss made a motion to approve the purchase of paint for the Street Department at a cost of \$15,204.35. Commissioner Rinella seconded the motion.

ON ROLL CALL VOTE COMMISSIONERS RINELLA, HIGHTOWER, WEBB AND GOSS AND MAYOR BUTLER ALL VOTED YEA.

Commissioner Rinella made a motion to approve the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of Marion and Public Works Laborer's Local 773 Union Contract for May 1, 2015 through April 30, 2019. Commissioner Hightower seconded the motion.

ON ROLL CALL VOTE COMMISSIONERS RINELLA, HIGHTOWER, WEBB AND GOSS ALL VOTED YEA. MAYOR BUTLER voted no.


Commissioner Goss made a motion to adjourn the meeting with Commissioner Rinella seconding the motion.
