CITY OF MARION – CONTINUED MEETING

June 20, 2016

Minutes of a Continued Meeting of the City Council of the City of Marion held in the Council Chambers at City Hall June 20, 2016. Mayor Butler called the meeting to order at 4:00 P.M. The City Clerk was instructed to call the roll. The response was as follows:

PHYSICALLY PRESENT: COMMISSIONERS RINELLA, HIGHTOWER, WEBB AND GOSS AND MAYOR BUTLER.

ABSENT: NONE

Director of Code Enforcement Jim Phemister told the Council Brenda Jessie is wanting to set a doublewide mobile home on a block foundation at 704 North Otis. Commissioner Hightower made a motion to approve the setting of a doublewide mobile home on the lot at 704 North Otis Street with Commissioner Rinella seconding the motion.

ON ROLL CALL VOTE COMMISSIONERS RINELLA, HIGHTOWER, WEBB AND GOSS AND MAYOR BUTLER ALL VOTED YEA.

Approval of the Hub Recreation Center drainage and flagpole project was tabled to the next Regular Council Meeting.

Commissioner Rinella made a motion to go out of Executive Session and resume the Continued Meeting with Commissioner Goss seconding the motion.

Mayor Butler stated to the public that if anyone does not think Marion is the Hub of the Universe, they should have been in Marion this past weekend. Not only did the Marion Cultural and Civic Center host the Miss Illinois Scholarship Pageant all week with the finale on Saturday night, but the Hank Williams Jr. concert sponsored by Black Diamond Harley Davidson drew thousands of visitors from all over the country, there were two Southern Illinois Miners home ballgames Friday and Saturday nights, fifty lady softball teams were competing at Ray Fosse Park, and last but not least over one hundred twenty winged Outlaw micro sprint cars from as far away as California, New York and Florida were competing Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights at Southern Illinois Raceway just east of Marion. These activities brought thousands of people to the City of Marion over the weekend.

Commissioner Goss made a motion to award HSG Mechanical Contractors Inc. a contract in the estimated amount of \$45,000.00 for corrosion correction and similar problems at the Hub Recreation Center on the basis of Boyt Engineering recommendation. Commissioner Rinella seconded the motion.


Commissioner Rinella made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Goss seconded the motion.
