

CITY OF MARION – CONTINUED MEETING

July 24, 2018

Minutes of a Continued Meeting held at Marion City Hall Wednesday, July 24, 2018 at 11:30 A.M. The Pledge to the American Flag was led by Mayor Rinella. Mayor Rinella called the meeting to order. The roll call response was as follows:

PHYSICALLY PRESENT: Commissioner Patton, Webb and Commissioner Goss and Mayor Rinella.

ABSENT: Commissioners Hightower.

Mayor Rinella stated this is a Continued Meeting from Monday July 23, 2018 to approve the bids for the construction of the following: PCC Pavement Special, Storm sewer and inlets, earth excavation and signalization of the intersection of West Main and Halfway Road.

Engineer Glenn Clarida presented the three bids:

Sierra Bravo	-\$2,112,901.59
E.T. Simonds	-\$2,176,564.43
Samron Midwest Contracting	-\$2,031,227.23
Engineer’s Estimate	-\$2,440,133.78

Commissioner Goss made a motion to approve Samron Construction as the low bidder at \$2,031,227.23 for the construction of the West Main and Halfway Road subject to the approval of DCEO. Commissioner Webb seconded the motion.

ON ROLL CALL VOTE COMMISSIONERS PATTON, WEBB AND GOSS AND MAYOR RINELLA ALL VOTED YEA. COMMISSIONER HIGHTOWER ABSENT.

Engineer Clarida stated the low bidder was approximately \$400,000.00 less that the Engineer’s Estimate.

Engineer Clarida stated the work will start with the grading for the road. Samron will sub-contract the dirt work to Burke of Murphysboro.


