

**CITY OF MARION – SPECIAL MEETING**

October 12, 2018

Minutes of a Special Meeting held at Marion City Hall Friday October 12, 2018 at 4:30 P.M. The Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag was led by Mayor Rinella. Mayor Rinella called the meeting to order. The roll call response was as follows:

PHYSICALLY PRESENT: Commissioner Hightower, Webb, Commissioner Goss and Mayor Rinella.

ABSENT: Commissioner Patton

Mayor Rinella stated this is a Special Meeting having given notice of the Special Meeting forty-eight hours prior to the meeting as stated in 05/ILCS 120/2.02 with the reason for the Special Called Meeting being as follows:

1. Council approval to apply for Safe Routes to School Grant for sidewalks along Boyton Street from Virginia Street to Court Street.
2. Council approval of bids to install emergency Storm Sewer lining, cost up to \$100,000.00. Budgeted item.
3. Ordinance 3472 – An Ordinance amending Ordinance 2283 – Section 5 and Section 6 – Amending penalties and Corrective action from a thirty-day time limit for a satisfactory correction to ten working days-time limit to make satisfactory correction.

Commissioner Goss made a motion to approve applying for the Safe Routes to School Grant for Sidewalks. Commissioner Webb seconded the motion.

Street Superintendent Doug Phillips stated that currently there are no continuous sidewalks on Boyton Street from Virginia Street to Court Street. The children must walk in the street.

Engineer Brian Ziegler stated Clarida and Ziegler Engineering will put together an application for the grant. The estimated cost of the sidewalk construction is \$246,000.00 with the grant paying 100% of the cost of construction up to \$200,000.00.

There being no further discussion, Mayor Rinella called for the vote.

ON ROLL CALL VOTE COMMISSIONER HIGHTOWER, WEBB AND COMMISSIONER GOSS AND MAYOR RINELLA ALL VOTED YEA. COMMISSIONER PATTON WAS ABSENT.

Item 2 to approve bids to install emergency Storm Sewer lining, cost up to \$100,000.00 was tabled.

ORDINANCE 3472 – ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2283 – SECTION 5 AND SECTION 6 – AMENDING PENALTIES AND CORRECTIVE ACTION FROM A THIRTY-DAY TIME LIMIT FOR A SATISFACTORY CORRECTION TO TEN WORKING DAYS-TIME LIMIT TO MAKE THE SATISFACTORY CORRECTION, WITH THE PENALTY BEING UP TO \$750.00 FOR EACH DAY THE SITUATION IS NOT CORRECTED AFTER THE TENTH DAY.

Commissioner Goss made a motion to approve Ordinance 3472 as presented with Commissioner Webb seconding the motion.

With no further discussion, Mayor Rinella called for the vote.


ON ROLL CALL VOTE COMMISSIONER HIGHTOWER, WEBB AND COMMISSIONER GOSS AND MAYOR RINELLA ALL VOTED YEA. COMMISSIONER PATTON WAS ABSENT.


With the business of the Special Meeting all completed, Mayor Rinella stated a motion to adjourn the meeting was in order.
